CEDAR POINT COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVES \$15 MILLION IN FUNDING ROUND LED BY FOCUS VENTURES

DERRY, NH, August 8, 2005 - Cedar Point Communications, Inc., the leader in integrated packet-based voice switching technologies for the cable industry, today announced that it has raised \$15 million in additional financing. The financing was led by Focus Ventures and included participation from existing investors Ascent Venture Partners, Battery Ventures, Charles River Ventures, Comcast Interactive Capital, JP Morgan Partners, Motorola Ventures and STAR Ventures.

The financing will be used to support increased manufacturing, marketing and sales activities in conjunction with rapidly increasing demand from cable system operators in the Americas for Cedar Point's SAFARI C³ Multimedia Switching System. In addition, the capital will fund Cedar Point's increasing activities in Europe and elsewhere.

"We invested in Cedar Point because their innovative approach has resulted in a significant number of customer wins," said Kevin McQuillan, general partner of Focus Ventures. "By integrating all of the components of distributed VoIP architectures into one unit, Cedar Point has created a differentiated product that has been selected for use by many of the major U.S. and Latin American cable system operators."
